About NACMP

The *National Association of Court Monitoring Programs* (NACMP) works to support the creation and expansion of court monitoring programs across the U.S. We believe that court monitoring is a vital and powerful tool in creating a criminal justice system that is effective and responsive to the needs of victims of domestic violence, sexual assault and child abuse. The NACMP provides training, technical assistance, and national organizing to organizations and individuals engaged in court monitoring activities and projects.

The NACMP is a program of WATCH. Based in Minneapolis, Minnesota, WATCH is a volunteer-based court monitoring and research organization that monitors and reviews cases of family and sexual violence and provides feedback to the justice system. Founded in Minneapolis in 1992, WATCH works to improve the justice system's response to cases of domestic abuse, child abuse and sexual assault.
